PROGRAM PARTNERSHIP

SUMMARY

The CareerLink Department is requesting City Council's approval of a partnership and authorization for the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Community Career Development (CCD) dba Rancho Dominguez America's Job Center of California (AJCC).

BACKGROUND

AJCC receives funding from Los Angeles County Workforce Development, Aging and Community Services to administer Youth@Work programs for Compton Youth ages 14-24. The AJCC administers programs for Youth that provide a work-based training environment with the goal to encourage youth to learn about the profession workplace skills within the job sector that will expose them to a variety of different career fields to encourage and further their develop career goals and interests. Objectively, the program will provide Compton youth with the opportunity to develop the skills necessary to meet their present and future employment goals.

The City's participation in this program includes various city departments' participation by selecting a youth to be assigned to their department. Currently, staff is working with all of the City departments to identify their needs and identify youth workers that will fit each department needs. This is a six (6) month program from December 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020.

Upon City Council approval, staff will coordinate final review and execution of the agreement with the City Attorney's Office.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact to the General Fund for this project. The salaries for the Youth workers will be paid by AJCC.

RECOMMENDATION
